Please read these cookies notice carefully before using Our Service.

Definitions

For the purposes of these Terms and Conditions:

- * Account means a unique account created for You to access our Service or parts of our Service.
- * Company (referred to as either "the Company", "We", "Us" or "Our" in this Agreement) refers to Reinfred Addo Central, 244 S Durham Street, Baltimore, Maryland 21231, on behalf of Reinfred Addo and Reinfred Addo Giftshop
- *Cookie means a small file placed on Your Device to make Our Service work the way You expect it to
- *Cookies banner means an information center that allows the user to accept or reject Cookies
- * Device means any device that can access the Service such as a computer, a cellphone or a digital tablet.
- * Service refers to the Website.
- * Website refers to raddocentral.com, as provided and hosted by Squarespace
- * You means the individual accessing or using the Service, or the company, or other legal entity on behalf of which such individual is accessing or using the Service, as applicable.

Cookies Information

We use Cookies and similar tracking technologies to track the activity on Our Service and store certain information. Tracking technologies used are beacons, tags, and scripts to collect and track information and to improve and analyze Our Service. The technologies We use may include:

* Web Beacons. * Strictly Necessary / Essential Cookies

Type: Session Cookies

Purpose: These Cookies are essential to provide You with services available through the Website and to enable You to use some of its features. They help to authenticate users and prevent fraudulent use of user accounts. Without these Cookies, the services that You have asked for cannot be provided, and We only use these Cookies to provide You with

those services.

Cookies Banner

*Our Service provides a Cookie banner. The following are ways You may interact with the Cookies banner for the site as a whole:

‘Cookies Settings’ opens an information box that allows You to read about Your privacy in general online, allows You to learn about the types of Cookies We use, and allows You to accept said Cookies or reject said Cookies

‘Reject All’ allows You to decline placing Cookies on Your Device.

‘Accept All Cookies’ allows You to opt-in into allowing placement of Strictly Necessary Cookies on Your Device. Because Strictly Necessary Cookies are Session Cookies, the Cookies placed on Your Device are deleted as soon as You close Your web browser.

‘X’ button functions in the same way as the ‘Reject All’ button.

*Our Service’s Cookies are opt-in, meaning the default position is that Cookies will not be placed on Your Device, even if no action has been taken by You (e.g., ‘Reject All’). The only action that will allow Cookies to be placed on Your Device is Your selecting ‘Accept All Cookies’.
